Adelaide Hills Equestrian Centre Conditions of Use

The Polocrosse fields and infrastructure at Lobethal are fully owned by the Lobethal Recreation and Sports Club and are managed by the Adelaide Polocrosse Club (APC).

All other equestrian lease the playing fields on a user pays basis.

The following conditions of use apply to all Equestrian groups and users who lease the Adelaide Hills Equestrian Centre. Failure to comply with the conditions of use may result in the user forfeiting the right to lease the grounds and or Club rooms on future occasions.

- 1. Dates of usage must be advised to the APC booking officer, conformation of the booking will be advised. Where a date may clash with another booking the possibility of sharing the facility may be offered. The person making the booking will have ultimate responsibility for the group using the facilities this person must ensure the conditions are followed.
- 2. A copy of up to date certificate of currency must be provided to the booking officer prior to final booking conformation.
- 3. Any individual riders wishing to use the fields when there is no organised event (e.g. private lessons) must supply a copy of their personal insurance policy to the APC committee and written permission must be received prior to use.
- 4. The key to the polocrosse clubrooms can be collected from the key code box by liaising with an authorised APC person prior to the booked event. The key must be returned to the key code area on completion of the event.
- 5. The polocrosse clubrooms are to be left in a clean and tidy state. The kitchen area must be cleaned and no foodstuff left to perish after the event.
- 6. Chairs and trestle tables must be stacked in a safe and orderly fashion.
- 7. No vehicles are to be driven on the fields. The only exception being utility vehicle used to convey equipment to the designated areas of use (i.e. to tow a trailer loaded with jumps etc.)
- 8. No parking on any playing field
- 9. Where the day yards are on the far side of field three are being used floats must not be driven across the fields, drive on tracks only.
- 10. Day yards must be used no horses will be to be tied to floats or vehicles for an extended time.
